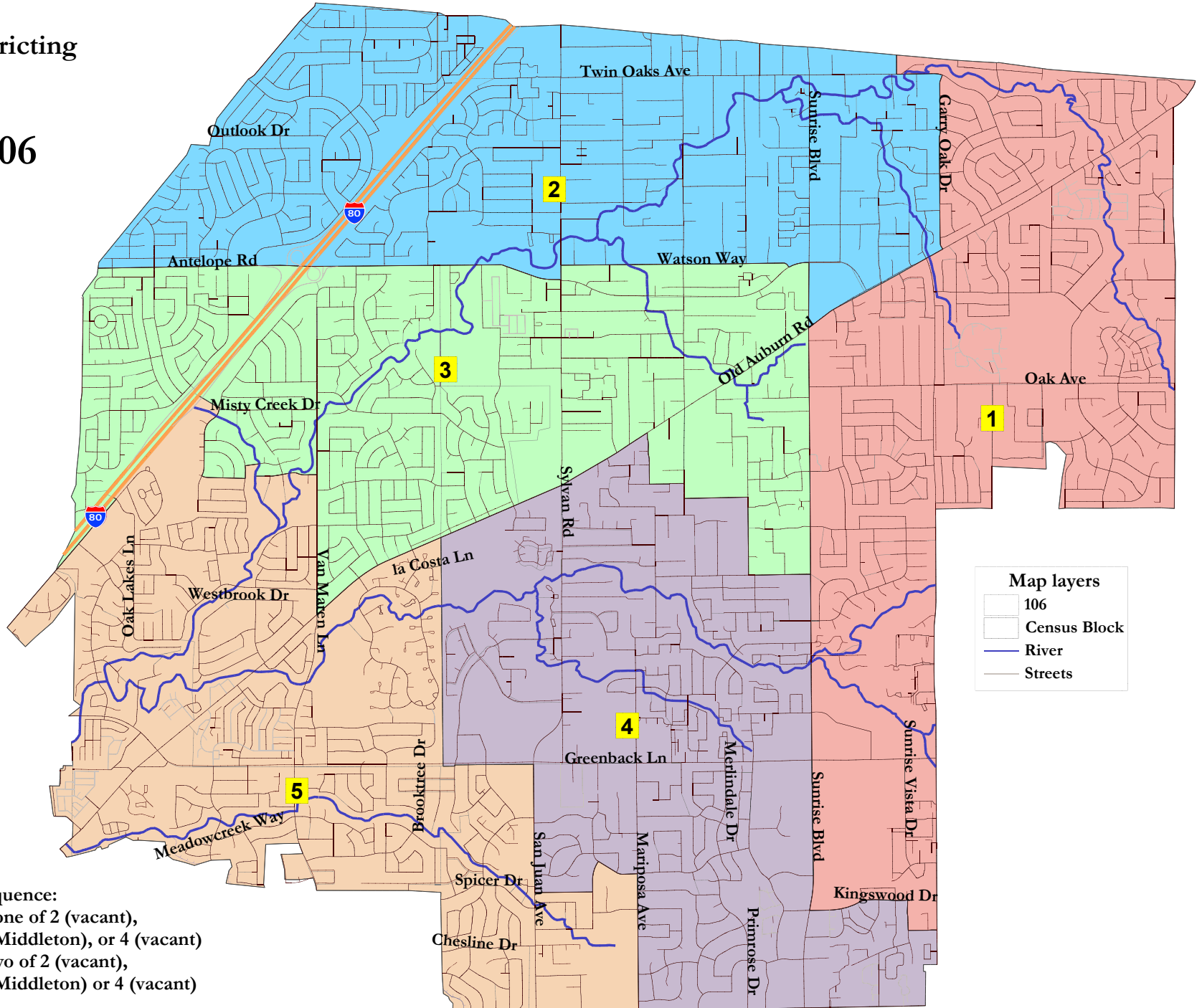


Citrus Heights
