11-30-12 Update: The Auburn Boulevard Project, Segment II, undergrounding of utilities from Rusch Park to Sylvan Corners and street improvements from Rusch Park to Sycamore Drive, is on schedule to be completed in Fall 2013. 10-22-12 Update: Contractor is working south of Pratt Ave on lowering water and sewer services for the joint trench and installing storm drain north of Pratt Ave. The retaining wall is being built between Pratt and Antelope. Finally, construction on the joint trench is occurring in multiple sections near Pratt Ave and working its way south.

10-1-12 Update: Contractor is installing storm drain and new water services as well as continuing joint trench work from Pratt Ave to Rusch Park. Lane closures include one lane, northbound Auburn from Pratt Ave. to Antelope Road.

9-13-12 Update: Starting September 19th, the City of Citrus Heights will be hosting an open meeting every Wednesday from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m. at Rusch Park (7801 Auburn Boulevard) in conference room #4. The meeting is casual and open for businesses, property owners or residents to drop in with their questions regarding the construction along Auburn Boulevard.

Location: Rusch Park (7801 Auburn Boulevard), Conference Room #4 is located in the northwest corner of the gym building. Entrance door is on the west face of the building.

Parking: Please use the parking lot behind the building (west side).

8-22-12 Update: Construction has started on Auburn Boulevard. Speeds on the Boulevard have been reduced to 25 MPH and speeding will be enforced. Please remember to drive safely.

7-2-12 Update: On June 28th the City Council authorized the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Teichert Construction for the Auburn Boulevard Project. Construction is expected to start at the end of July.

5-10-12 Update: An Auburn Boulevard meeting for residents will be held Monday, May 14, 2012 at 6:30 p.m. in the Rusch Park Gymnasium (7801 Auburn Boulevard).

2-24-12 Update: On Thursday, February 23rd, the City Council approved \$8.1 million in City funds for the Auburn Boulevard Project. The Council also approved agreements with utility companies including SMUD, PG&E, Citrus Heights Water District, Comcast, Sprint and Surewest for contributing to the cost of undergrounding utilities for the project. With these approvals, the City Council authorized the project to be advertised for construction. Staff is currently preparing the project bid package for release in late March.

2-21-12 Update: On Thursday, February 23rd the Citrus Heights City Council will review and consider approval of project funding and authorization to bid for the Auburn Boulevard Complete Streets Revitalization Project.
