

**NOTICE** is hereby given that on **March 24, 2022** at **7:15 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, the **City Council** of the City of Citrus Heights will hold a Public Hearing at the **City Council Chambers** located at **6360 Fountain Square Drive, Citrus Heights, CA** and via **Zoom** (some, or all, Council Members may attend the City Council meeting telephonically or otherwise electronically) to receive input regarding potential redistricting of Council Member districts.

Pursuant to Elections Code Section 21607, the City is conducting a Public Hearing to 1) receive a report on the redistricting process and permissible criteria to be considered to redraw City Council election district boundaries; and 2) conduct a public hearing to receive public input on the redistricting process and permissible criteria (including without limitation district boundaries and composition thereof).

All interested persons are invited to participate and comment during the Public Hearing. Written public comments shall be limited to 250 words or less. Each comment will be read aloud by the City Clerk.
