WELCOME, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE, INTRODUCTIONS, AGENDA REVIEW

<u>Glenda Green, President of Area 3</u>, welcomed attendees, had them introduce themselves, led the Pledge of Allegiance and reviewed the agenda.

PROGRAM

CHPD Representative - Lt. Dunning

Lt. Dunning gave a presentation about the return of the Problem Oriented Policing team (P.O.P. Team), focused on facilitation and enforcement of community concerns including blight and beautification, quality of life, and chronic nuisance offenses. Current officers of P.O.P Team include Lt. Lt. Dunning also provided information about CPTED, Crime Prevention through Environmental Design, which includes encouraging better lighting, surveillance, and natural access control for frequently targeted properties. Also discussion about Letter of Agency program which allows property owners to sign an agreement allowing police to do enforcement on that property without needing to contact owner each time. Also, once again, a reminder to utilize SEE, CLICK, FIX app for problems.

<u>**Q&A**</u> - P.O.P Teams reception was positive overall, however a concern was raised about the use of taxpayer dollars to clean up commercial property, when private property isn't being addressed in the same manner.
