## What Goes Inside My Brown Trash Cart?

- ✓ Aseptic packaging (milk, soy and juice cartons)
- ✓ Ceramics
- ✓ Children's toys (batteries removed)
- ✓ Cotton or clothing
- ✓ Contaminated paper items
- ✓ Flimsy plastic or bubble wrap
- ✓ Hoses
- ✓ Light bulbs (halogen, incandescent, and, LED)
- ✓ Metal hangers
- ✓ Packing peanuts (stuff into a plastic bag)
- ✓ Plastic-coated milk cartons
- ✓ Waxed paper

- PLEASE DO NOT PLACE RECYCLABLES OR GREEN WASTE IN THE TRASH CART.
- ALL MATERIAL MUST FIT INSIDE CART WITH LID CLOSED.

**3 FEET BETWEEN CARTS:**  
Keep at least three (3) feet of space between your carts and other objects (like mailboxes), and keep carts six (6) feet away from vehicles and large objects.



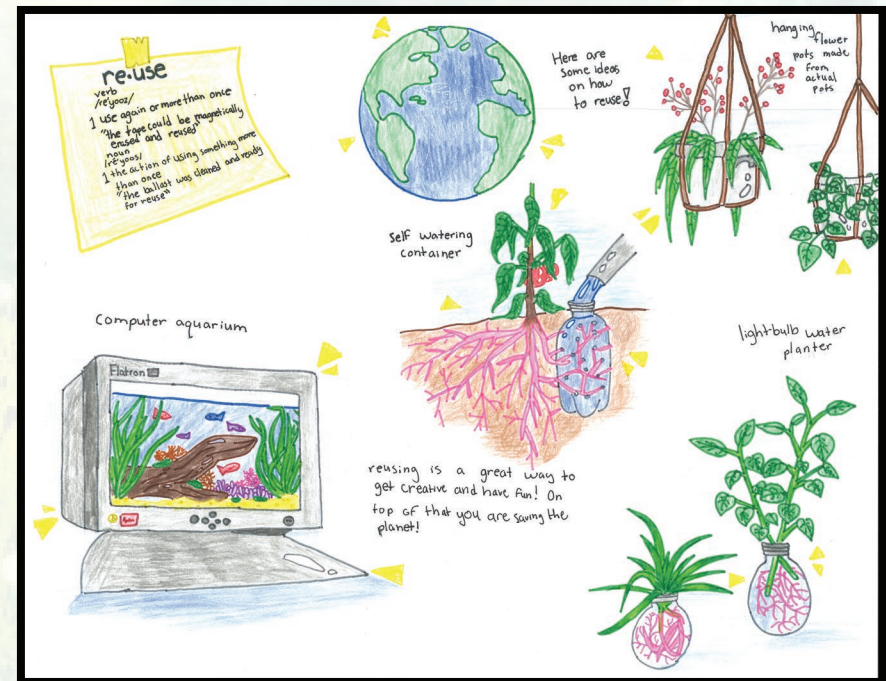
## Keep These Items Out Of Your Brown Cart

- ⊘ Electronics (TVs, computers)
- ⊘ CFLs (twisty bulbs and tubes), Neon lights
- ⊘ Hazardous materials
- ⊘ Hot ashes and coals
- ⊘ Household batteries (AA, AAA, C, D, 9V, button and lithium)\*
- ⊘ Medical waste, sharps (syringes, etc.)\*\*
- ⊘ Used motor oil and filters\*

\*See the month of August for information on recycling batteries and used motor oil and filters.

\*\*See the month of September for more information on disposal of home generated sharps.
